NOTICE TO ALL CUSTOMERS

OGGETTO /
REFERENCE : **COMMUNITARY DIRECTIVES 2002/95/EC (RoHS) AND 2002/96/EC (WEEE).**

With regard to Communitary Directives **2002/95/EC (RoHS – Restriction of the use of certain Hazardous Substances in electrical and electronic equipment)** and **2002/96/EC (WEEE – Waste of Electrical and Electronic Equipment)**,

POSTULATING THAT:

- *“The purpose of Both Directives is, as a first priority, the prevention of waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE), and in addition, the reuse, recycling and other forms of recovery of such wastes so as to reduce the disposal of waste. They also seek to improve the environmental performance of all operators involved in the life cycle of electrical and electronic equipment, e.g. producers, distributors and consumers and in particular those operators directly involved in the treatment of waste electrical and electronic equipment”.*
- Both Directives are applicable to the products listed in the **annex 1A** (“Categories of electrical and electronic equipment covered by this Directive...”) of the Communitary Directive **2002/96/EC (WEEE)** and made more explicit by the **annex 1B** (“List of products which shall be taken into account for the purpose of this Directive and which fall under the categories of Annex 1A...”) of the same Directive, in which pumps or motor-pump units are not included.

WE DECLARE THAT:

- The Communitary Directives **2002/95/EC (RoHS)** and **2002/96/EC (WEEE)** are not applicable to our products. No conformity declaration of our product may, therefore, be released towards Communitary Directives which are not applicable to the product itself.

- The substances dangerous for human health listed in the Community Directive **2002/95/EC (RoHS)**, *Lead (Pb)*, *Mercury (Mg)*, *Cadmium (Cd)*, *Hexavalent Chromium (Cr VI)*, *Polybrominated Biphenyls (PBB)*, *Polybrominated Diphenyl Ethers (PBDE)*, with the exception of what stated in the **annex** “*Applications of Lead, Mercury, Cadmium and Hexavalent Chromium which are exempted from the requirements of Article 4 (1)...*” enclosed in the same Directive, are not and haven’t ever been contained in any of our product’s components.
